

**The Victorian Flying Scale Aircraft Association
Invites all Scale Modellers to participate in the**

VicScale Trophy

9th – 10th June 2018



This is a competition generally in accordance with the MAAA Large Scale rules but with no minimum size limitation. The event has two sections, Flying only and Scale. Models exceeding 7kg must have a permit to fly.

The Flying only section is open to any model, scratch built, kit or ARF and will not be subject to static judging and no documentation is required.

The Scale section is for models built from scratch, plans or kits. These models will be statically judged and will require documentation in line with the

MAAA rules for Large Scale competition. If the model has been previously statically judged by the VFSA and appears in their database, static judging will not be required.

Depending on entry numbers and weather conditions, two rounds of flying will be carried out on each day with static judging during the flying. The average of the best two flight scores will determine the placing of the ARF section. The average of the best two flight scores will be added to the static score to determine the placing in the Scale section.

Flying will commence at 9:30am. The draw for flying will be made prior to commencement of flying on Saturday.
